Zebra 180-grit Nail File, Milk & Honey Hand & Body Dry Oil, Gel Polish Soak Off Nail Foils & Cotton, Ultra Birchwood Manicure Sticks, Pterygium Remover & Spoon Pusher, Four-Sided Soft Whit Polar Block, Conditioning Soak Off Solution.

LET'S BEGIN PRODUCT REMOVAL!



1 Remove the gel top coat with a 180-grit file.

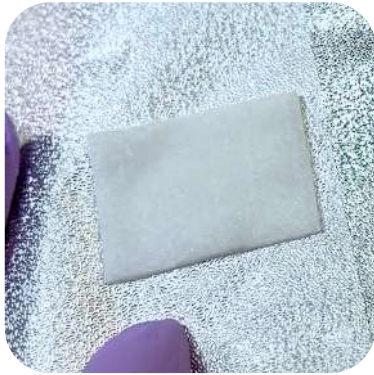


2 Add Milk & Honey Hand & Body Dry Oil to protect the cuticle and surrounding skin during soaking.

VERSATILITY GEL – GEL REMOVAL



3 Add Conditioning Soak Off Solution to cotton, place on the nail and wrap with a Gel Polish Soak Off Nail Foil.



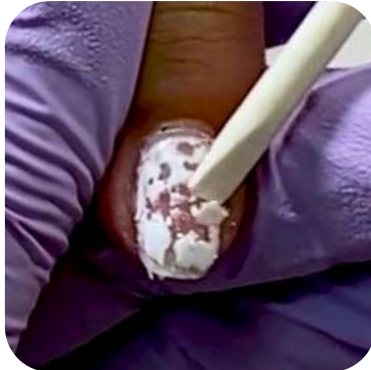
4 Place the cotton pad over the nail, then fold the wrap around the finger & squeeze corners to secure. Continue to wrap all fingers.

PRO TIP

Product removes faster with heat so cover the hands in a towel or a hot wet towel to speed up the process



5 Cover hands with a towel & allow to soak for 15-20 minutes.



6 Squeeze the wrap & pull it off the nail. Remove any softened product with a birchwood stick.



7 If needed, use a 180-grit file to remove product.



8 Use a 180-grit file to shape the free-edge of all the nails.



9 If any product remains on the nails, gently remove with a 180-grit file.



10 If needed, gently push back the cuticle.

VERSATILITY GEL – GEL REMOVAL



11 Use a buffer to remove any remaining product & smooth the surface of the nail. Remove any dust & debris.



12 Moisturize the nail & surrounding skin with Milk & Honey Hand & Body Dry Oil. Massage the oil into the skin.



13 Finish nails with an ASP Nail Treatment or Long Wear Top Coat.
